

10 Alerts That Will Make Internet Banking *Work Smarter for You*

All Internet Banking alerts can be sent to up to five e-mail accounts, except the Sign-on Notification. You can also send alerts to any mobile device or cell phone that has a valid e-mail address. You may need to contact your mobile or cell phone provider for additional information.

- 1- **Sign-on Notification.** Any time your account is logged into, you will be notified through e-mail. This security alert can only be sent to your primary e-mail account.
- 2- **Activity Account Summary.** Receive an alert each morning with the prior day's transactions. This will include deposits, withdrawals, and the ending balance on the account. Use this to ensure your checking account is balanced.
- 3- **Account Balance Change.** Receive an alert when an account balance is below or above a specific dollar amount. For example, if you set up an alert to let you know when your checking balance goes below \$500, you will receive an e-mail whenever that happens.
- 4- **Check Cleared.** Receive an alert when a certain check number clears, up to five checks.
- 5- **Custom Message.** Set up an alert for any purpose, for any time. Use this for birthday reminders, payments due, doctor's appointment, etc.
- 6- **Electronic Deposit.** Receive an alert any time you receive an ACH (automated clearinghouse/electronic) deposit such as direct deposit of your paycheck, tax return, a Check Card purchase return, etc.
- 7- **Large Amount Withdrawal.** Monitor your account by getting notified of any withdrawal over a certain dollar amount.
- 8- **Non-Sufficient Funds.** Receive an alert any time a check is returned to the recipient because you did not have enough funds in your account to cover it.
- 9- **Savings/Check Card Transaction.** Receive an alert each time a transaction occurs from using your Savings Card or Check Card. Use this as a reminder to enter transactions into your checking account register to keep your account balanced.
- 10- **Stop Payment Expires.** If you have a stop payment request set up, you will be notified 10 days before the stop payment will expire.
